

Can girls bend it like Beckham?

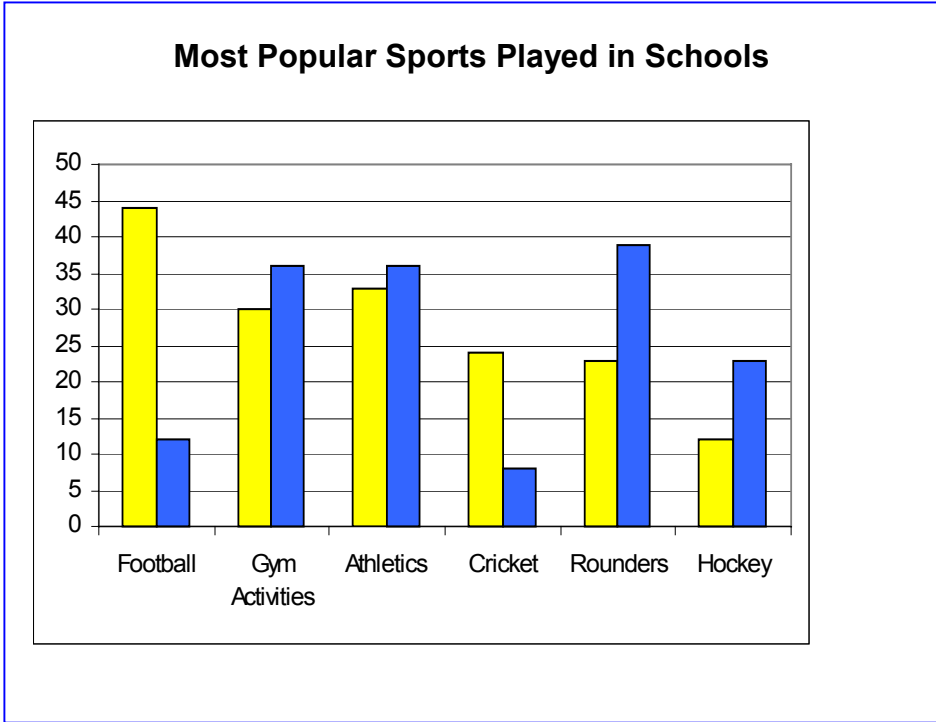

Doing sport is good for you! Some other 'activities' often aren't. According to the National Centre for Social Research (England 2001), 14% of 12 year old boys had drunk alcohol in the previous week, compared with 11% of girls. By 15, this rose to 54% for boys and 50% for girls. Can you draw the data as a comparative bar chart, like the one above?
